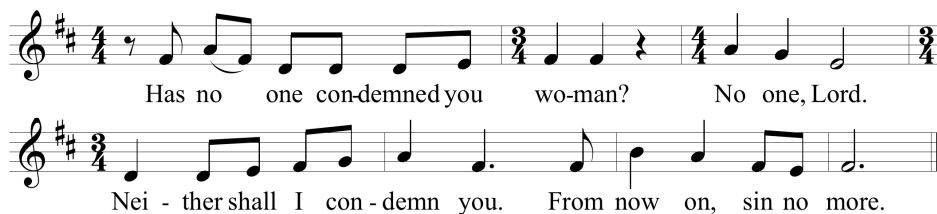

After the first three pick-ups by the new vendor, our parish received a stipend of \$273.28, which will benefit the Msgr. Christopher Scholarship Fund.
