# NEW STATEMENT FROM CARDINAL-DESIGNATE WILTON D. GREGORY ON THE VATICAN "MCCARRICK" REPORT

On November 10, the Vatican released the Report detailing the Vatican's knowledge, decision-making, and investigation related to former Cardinal Theodore Edgar McCarrick from the years of 1930 to 2017. According to Vatican officials, this report was prepared by the Secretariat of State by mandate of Pope Francis. After his complete reading of the report, Washington Cardinal-Designate Wilton Gregory released a new statement on November 16, 2020. 
