There was no business meeting afterwards. The John Neumann unit will attend the November union meeting at St. Augustine in NE.

A. Prefect – Poupee's focus is on the Communion Breakfast.

B. Treasurer –Suzie has reconciled bank account through August. She needs to get the September statement from George Cruz. We have \$15,290 cash balance right now. She has only written a few checks for this year, but knows there are some outstanding expenses from the lasagna dinner. She has received dues from John Neumann Unit. A reminder to units is that we have committed to getting unit dues in by December.

C. Units -

1. Christ Child Unit – Their meeting at the Seton Center went well. It is good location for them. They have a new member hosting the October meeting. Gail will follow up with their unit treasurer Ann about dues. They agreed to move to donating monies directly to Centro Tepeyac rather than goods. They have 18 members, 15 of whom are active. They continue to welcome and take prayer requests, and Gail got an excellent response after the general meeting.

2. John Neumann Unit – held their meeting on Sept. 9. They meet again on November 11.

3.Regina Coeli – Unit had their first meeting on Sept. 22. Attendance was very good with close to 20 members. Their next meeting will be on Nov 20th - which is the Giving Tree Label meeting. The calendar for the year was reviewed and sent out to all members including to members not in attendance. The template to collect information for members was passed around. The template has been sent to all members asking them to review and update. They have also designated one person to follow up with each member who may not have been active lately, to ensure they still feel part of the unit. Maureen W. will serve as the Treasurer for our unit. Many members paid the dues the night of the meeting. They will use the template to follow up with members - anticipating that dues will be paid by mid December. They discussed ongoing projects that the Unit will be continuing which include: Giving Tree, Collection of food every Sunday in the back of church - for Assumption Parish, Providing dinner to Catholic students at Univ. of MD Catholic Student Center. They also discussed new projects for the year including: Serving food to the homeless. Catholic Charities provides dinner on Wed. evenings on G St. in DC, Organizing a Christmas Tea at Maplewood with Christ Child members and other Sodalists living at Maplewood, Broaden support for Sacred Heart Parish by seeing if they need more assistance year round like school supplies, teaching English, etc. The unit will be welcoming Tricia Klosky as a new member - at their next meeting.
